

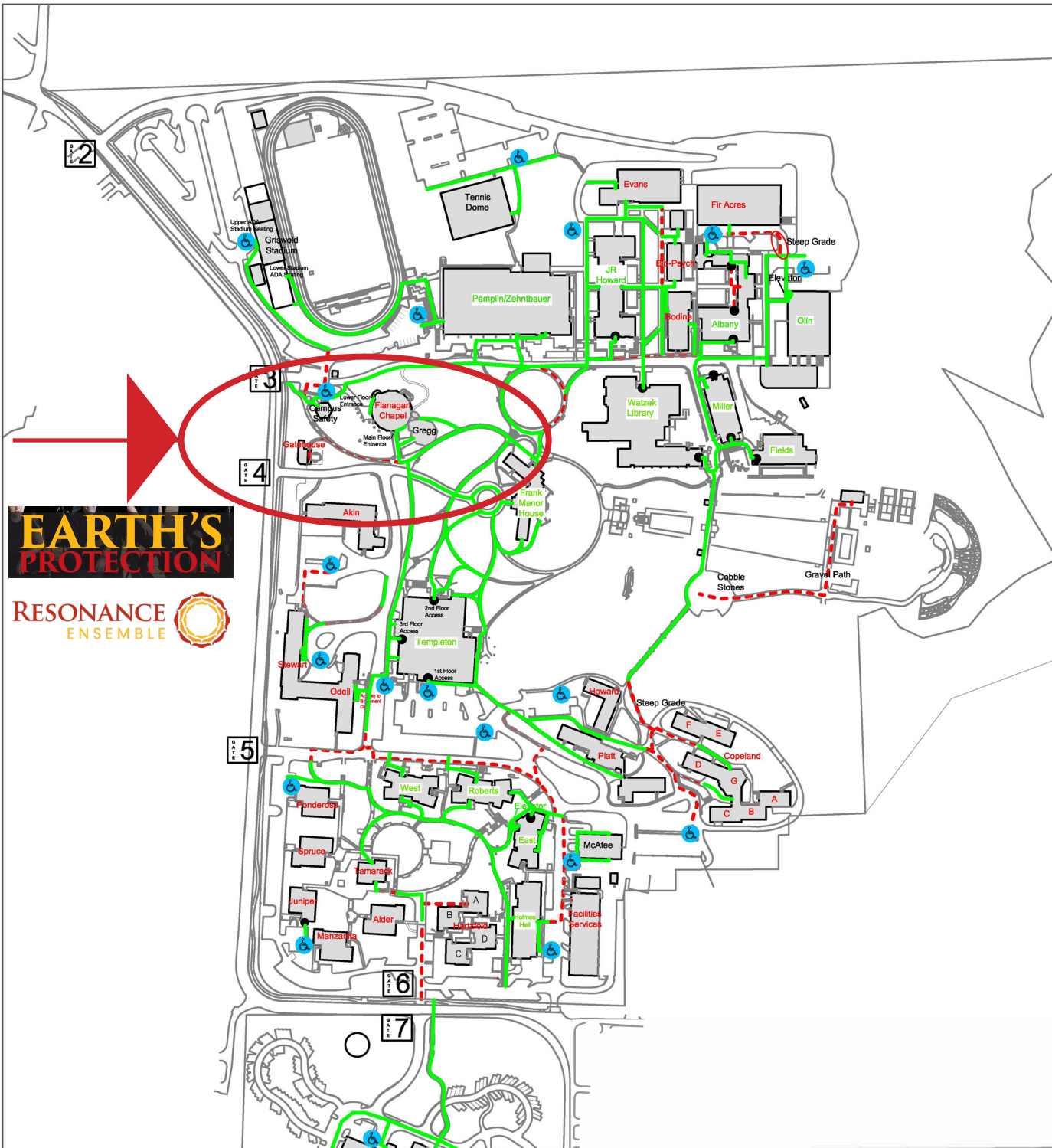
Lewis & Clark Campus Access Map
